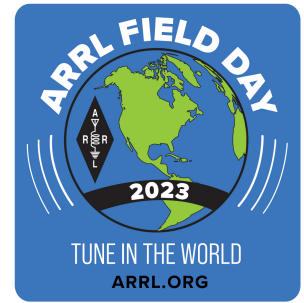




Sask Alta Field Day

What is ARRL Field Day?

Field Day is ham radio's open house. Every June, more than 40,000 hams throughout North America set up temporary transmitting stations in public places to demonstrate ham radio's science, skill and service to our communities and our nation. It combines public service, emergency preparedness, community outreach, and technical skills all in a single event. Field Day has been an annual event since 1933, and remains the most popular event in ham radio.

What we are be doing:

We will be setting up just after 9 AM on June 24 and operational at noon. The school has facilities and lots of camping space. Bring a cot, tent or trailer if you wish to over night. Is a come and go event that allows us to practice and demonstrate our capabilities in the event communication network failures.
